Section 1. The provisions of Act 2014-429 as they 1 2 apply to employers participating in the Employees' Retirement System pursuant to Sections 36-27-6, 36-27-7, and 36-27-7.1 3 4 shall be extended if a participating employer elects to come under the provisions of Act 2014-429 by official resolution on 5 or before September 30, 2015. Upon such election by official 6 7 resolution on or before September 30, 2015, the lump-sum payments provided under Act 2014-429 shall be paid to all 8 eligible recipients who are entitled to receive a lump-sum 9 10 payment under Act 2014-429 and are receiving a benefit as of 11 September 30, 2015 by the Employees' Retirement System in 12 December 2015. Any employer making such election shall bear the cost of the lump-sum payment paid to its retirees, as 13 provided in Act 2014-429. 14

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
