- 4 Section 1. Section 41-21-1, Code of Alabama 1975, is

- "(a) It shall be the duty of the Secretary of State,

 on publication and delivery to the state, to transmit sets of

 the Code of Alabama 1975, and supplements or replacement

 volumes thereof, subject to subsection (b), to all of the

- 12 boards, commissions, and offices:
- "(1) One set to the law library of Congress.

 - "(4) Up to two sets One set to each member of the Legislature and the Lieutenant Governor, for each legislative term, and to the Clerk of the House of Representatives and to the Secretary of the Senate.
- "(5) One set to the library of each junior college, trade school, technical college, and public institution of higher education.

7	offices of circuit clerk and of register are held by the same
8	person, only one set shall be provided.
9	" $(39)(13)$ One set to the clerk of the district court
10	and juvenile court in counties where clerks' offices for these
11	courts are maintained.
12	" (40) (14) One set to the probate judge of each
13	county.
14	" $\frac{(41)}{(15)}$ One set to every justice of the Supreme
15	Court and every judge of the Court of Criminal Appeals and
16	Court of Civil Appeals and one set to each law clerk or
17	research assistant thereof.
18	" (42) (16) One set each to the Clerk of the Supreme
19	Court, Court of Criminal Appeals, Court of Civil Appeals, and
20	Reporter of Decisions.
21	" $\frac{(43)}{(17)}$ One set to every judge of the circuit and
22	district courts.
23	"(44)(18) One set to every district attorney and
24	deputy district attorney.
25	" $(45)(19)$ One set to the office of the Secretary of
26	the Senate for the use of the Senate and one set to the office

of the Clerk of the House of Representatives for the use of the House of Representatives.

"(46)(20) One set to the mayor or other executive or presiding officer of each municipality for use of such municipality.

"(47) Two sets to the Alabama State Bar Association.

"(48) Five sets to the Clerk of the House of
Representatives and five sets to the Secretary of the Senate.

- "(b) Code sets, annual supplements, and replacement volumes shall be provided to each eligible recipient under subsection (a) upon written request submitted by the recipient to the Secretary of State. The written request shall be filed once every four years within 30 days of receipt of a notice provided by the Secretary of State to the recipient concerning the necessity of filing a written request. The notice shall be provided by the Secretary of State within one month after the first legislative day of the first regular session of a legislative quadrennium.
- "(c) Notwithstanding subsection (b), the code sets, annual supplements, and replacement volumes distributed to members of the Legislature shall be provided unless the member submits a written request to the Secretary of State declining these volumes.
- "(d) The Secretary of State shall provide notice to an eligible recipient who newly assumes a vacated office within 30 days of being informed of the filling of the vacancy. The eligible recipient shall have 30 days from

1	receipt of the notice from the Secretary of State to file a
2	written request for code sets, annual supplements, and
3	replacement volumes. Upon receipt of the request, the
4	Secretary of State shall provide the materials to the eligible
5	recipient during the remainder of the four-year period."
6	Section 2. This act shall become effective
7	immediately following its passage and approval by the
8	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
