20	To amend Section 41-9-410 of the Code of Alabama
21	1975, relating to the Women's Commission; to change the
22	membership of the commission, and to specify the number of
23	members constituting a quorum for holding meetings and
24	conducting business.
25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Section 41-9-410 of the Code of Alabama
27	1975, is amended to read as follows:

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"§41-9-410.

2 "(a) There is hereby created and established a continuing Women's Commission, hereinafter referred to as the 3 4 commission, which shall be composed of three members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the 5 6 House, two members of the Senate appointed by the President 7 Pro Tem of the Senate, and 10 the following members appointed 8 by the Governor. Of those members appointed by the Governor, 9 one: One member shall be appointed from each congressional 10 district as the same are established on September 20, 1971, 11 and two three members shall be appointed from the 12 state-at-large. The additional at-large membership created by the 2015 act amending this section shall be appointed by the 13 Governor in 2015, for a term of two years. Successors to this 14 15 position shall serve a term of five years. No existing member's term of office may be shortened due to the creation 16 of the additional at-large membership. At least seven of the 17 members appointed by the Governor shall be women. The original 18 five members representing the Legislature shall be appointed 19 for terms of two years, and their successors shall be 20 21 appointed for terms of two years. Of those members initially 22 appointed by the Governor, five members shall be appointed for 23 terms of five years, and five members shall be appointed for terms of three years, and the successors to such 10 appointees 24 25 shall serve for terms of five years.

"(b) Five members of the commission shall constitute
 a quorum for purposes of holding meetings and transacting the
 business of the commission.

4 "(c) Members shall be selected on the basis of their
5 interests and knowledge in, and their ability to make
6 contributions to, the solutions of problems related to the
7 status of women.

8 "<u>(d)</u> The commission shall report to the Governor and 9 the Legislature.

10 "(e) Vacancies on the commission shall be filled by 11 appointment in the same manner provided for the appointment of 12 the initial members. Any appointment to replace a member whose 13 position becomes vacant prior to the expiration of the term 14 shall be filled only for the remainder of the term.

15 "<u>(f)</u> Members of the commission shall receive no
16 compensation for their services, except that they may be
17 reimbursed for reasonable and necessary expenses incident to
18 their duties as members of the commission, in accordance with
19 state law."

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 21 first day of the third month following its passage and 22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
