Relating to the City of Valley in Chambers County;
authorizing the sale of certain alcoholic beverages in the
municipality on Sundays under certain conditions.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. This act applies only in the City of8 Valley in Chambers County.

Section 2. The sale of alcoholic beverages after 9 10 12:00 p.m. on Sundays may be authorized by the city council 11 within the corporate limits of the City of Valley after 12 approval by a referendum as provided in this act. If the 13 Sunday sale of alcoholic beverages is approved by a 14 referendum, the city council of the city, by ordinance, may 15 permit the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages on 16 Sunday after 12:00 p.m. as determined by the city council by 17 properly licensed retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. Pursuant to this authority, the city council 18 19 may regulate which retail licensees may sell alcoholic beverages on Sunday, whether the sale may be for off-premises 20 21 consumption, and any other aspect of the Sunday sale of 22 alcoholic beverages.

23 Section 3. The city shall hold a referendum to 24 determine if the public favors the sale of alcoholic beverages 25 on Sunday after 12:00 p.m. If a majority of the voters voting thereon vote in favor of the question, then the sale of alcoholic beverages after 12:00 p.m. on Sunday may be provided for by the city council.

Section 4. The referendum shall be held at the next regular election or at a special election called for that purpose by the city council. Costs of the referendum shall be paid by the city. A second or subsequent referendum shall not be held within 12 months following a referendum which fails to be approved by the voters of the city.

10 Section 5. This act shall become effective 11 immediately following its passage and approval by the 12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
