25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Section 36-12-41 of the Code of Alabama
27	1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§36-12-41.

2 "(a) Every public officer having the custody of a
3 public writing which a citizen has a right to inspect is bound
4 to give him, on demand, a certified copy of it, on payment of
5 the legal fees therefor, and such copy is admissible as
6 evidence in like cases and with like effect as the original
7 writing.

8 "(b) Any public officer who refuses to release or 9 provide any public writing or document upon an order from a 10 court of competent jurisdiction, in addition to any contempt 11 powers of the court, shall be personally subject to civil 12 penalties in the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100) for each 13 day that the public officer refuses to release or provide the 14 public writing as ordered by the court."

15 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 16 first day of the third month following its passage and 17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
