17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted in
19	Section 104 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, in Shelby
20	County there is hereby levied and shall be collected a sales
21	tax at the rate of five percent upon the wholesale and retail
22	price, excluding taxes, of spirituous or vinous liquors sold
23	at retail or wholesale in the county by the Alcoholic Beverage
24	Control Board, its stores, or its successors or assigns. The
25	county tax herein levied shall be collected by the board, its
26	successors, or assigns, from the wholesale and retail
27	purchaser at the time the wholesale or retail price is paid.

The tax shall be collected as are other taxes on alcoholic
beverages and distributed to the Shelby County District
Attorney's Office for deposit into the District Attorney Fund.
The proceeds shall be distributed by the District Attorney's
Office as follows:

6 Forty-five percent of the proceeds shall be retained 7 by the office of the District Attorney in the District Attorney Fund for the operation of a special District 8 Attorney's Narcotic Investigation Unit or a Special 9 10 Prosecution Unit or a Combined Unit; 40 percent of the proceeds shall be distributed to the Shelby County Drug 11 Enforcement Task Force for the use and benefit of the entity 12 13 for drug investigations and drug abuse awareness, provided 14 that, if the entity for any reason cease to exist or fail to 15 perform functions consistent with the entity's stated purpose, the funds may be redirected at the sole discretion of the 16 17 District Attorney for any law enforcement purpose consistent with the stated purpose of the Shelby County Drug Enforcement 18 Task Force; and 15 percent of the proceeds shall be 19 20 distributed by the District Attorney for the purpose of child 21 protection and investigation or counseling related to child 22 abuse, or both investigation and counseling.

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board may withhold five percent of the tax collected under this act for costs of administration and collection not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per year.

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Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
