2	of county commissions, one county treasurer in all counties

4	precinct all constables in counties having constables, shall
5	be elected on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
6	November 2008, and every fourth year thereafter.

8	"(a) There shall be one constable for each election
9	precinct in each county, to Each constable shall be elected as
10	provided by law, who and shall hold office for four years from
11	the first Monday after the second Tuesday in January next
12	after his election and until his successor is elected and
13	qualified.
14	"(b) Constables shall be elected from geographical
15	areas as follows:
16	"(1) For counties having a population less than
17	30,000, one constable from each election precinct.
18	"(2) For counties having a population of at least
19	30,000 but less than 200,000, one constable from each county
