4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To amend Section 26-1-3.1, Code of Alabama 1975, to  
6 authorize persons age 18 years of age or older to consent to  
7 donate blood without the permission of a parent or guardian;  
8 to provide that consent is not subject to later disaffirmance;  
9 and to repeal Section 26-1-3, Code of Alabama 1975.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. Section 26-1-3.1, Code of Alabama 1975,  
12 is amended to read as follows:

13 "§26-1-3.1.

14 "(a) A person who is 17 years of age or older may  
15 consent to donate blood in a voluntary and noncompensatory  
16 blood donation program without the permission of a parent or  
17 guardian. The consent is not subject to later disaffirmance  
18 because of minority.

19 "(b) A person who is 16 years of age may donate  
20 blood in a voluntary and noncompensatory blood donation  
21 program if the person obtains written permission from the  
22 person's parent or guardian.

23 "(c) A person 18 years of age or older may consent  
24 to donate blood or plasma without the permission of a parent

1 or guardian. The consent is not subject to later disaffirmance  
2 because of minority."

3 Section 2. Section 26-1-3, Code of Alabama 1975, is  
4 repealed.

5 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the  
6 first day of the third month following its passage and  
7 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
