Section 23-1-241, Code of Alabama 1975, 10 11 is amended to read as follows: "§23-1-241. 12 13 "For the purposes of this division, the following 14 terms shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them by 15 this section: 16 "(1) (3) AUTOMOBILE GRAVEYARD RECYCLER. Any 17 establishment or place of business which is maintained, used, 18 or operated for storing, keeping, buying or selling wrecked, 19 scrapped, ruined, or dismantled motor vehicles or motor vehicle parts. 20 21 "(2) (6) DIRECTOR. The State Department of 22 Transportation. 23 "(3) (4) INTERSTATE SYSTEM. That portion of the 24 national system of interstate and defense highways located 25 within this state or officially designated, or as may

hereafter be so designated, by the director and approved by the United States Department of Transportation pursuant to the provisions of Title 23, United States Code, "Highways."

4 "(4) (1) JUNK. Old or scrap copper, brass, rope,
5 rags, batteries, paper trash, rubber debris, waste or junked,
6 dismantled or wrecked automobiles, or parts thereof, iron,
7 steel, and other old or scrap ferrous or nonferrous material.

8 "<u>(5)</u> <del>(2)</del> JUNKYARD. Any establishment or place of 9 business which is maintained, operated, or used for storing, 10 keeping, buying, or selling junk or for the maintenance or 11 operation of an automobile graveyard recycler. The term shall 12 include garbage dumps and sanitary fills.

13 "(6) (5) PRIMARY SYSTEM. That portion of connected 14 main highways as officially designated, or as may hereafter be 15 so officially designated, by the Director of Transportation 16 and approved by the United States Department of Transportation 17 pursuant to Title 23, United States Code, "Highways." Any 18 highway that is on the National Highway System, as defined under federal law, which includes the Interstate Highway 19 20 System.

"(7) SCRAP PROCESSOR. Any person, firm, or corporation engaged only in the business of buying scrap iron and metals, including, but not limited to, old automobiles, for the specific purpose of processing into raw material for remelting purposes only and whose principal product is ferrous

and nonferrous scrap for shipment to steel mills, foundries, smelters, and refineries and maintaining an established place of business in this state and having facilities and machinery designed for such processing."

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective 6 immediately following its passage and approval by the 7 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
