26	program shall be determined by the State Board of Education.

(b) The minimum instruction in civics shall include information on the formation and governing documents of the United States of America, the system of government employed by the United States of America, the formation and governing documents of the State of Alabama, and the system of government employed by the State of Alabama. The minimum instruction shall further include information on the interaction of federal and state governments and the roles played in our society by each as well as the obligations of citizenship and public participation in government.

(c) This section does not establish new required courses. The instructional programs required by this section shall be included in existing required courses as determined by the State Board of Education.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
