"(a) The driver of any motor vehicle involved in an accident not resulting in apparent serious physical injury as defined in Section 13A-1-2 to or the death of any person, or in damage to a motor vehicle or other vehicle which is driven or attended by any person, shall immediately stop such move the vehicle at the scene of such accident or as close thereto as possible from the roadway to the shoulder, emergency lane, median, or other location close to the accident site if the vehicle is drivable and can be safely moved from the roadway and shall then forthwith return to and in every event shall remain at as close to the scene of the accident as safely possible until he or she the driver has fulfilled the requirements of Section 32-10-3. Every such stop shall be made without obstructing traffic more than is necessary. The driver or any other person who has moved a motor vehicle from the roadway as provided herein before the arrival of a law enforcement officer shall not be considered at fault regarding the cause of the accident solely by reason of moving the vehicle and shall not be considered as having failed to stop and report a traffic accident.

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"(b) Employees of the Department of Transportation
may move a vehicle, require a vehicle to be moved, or assist
in the moving of a vehicle from the roadway under the
jurisdiction of the department if the vehicle is disabled as a
result of an accident and the disabled vehicle creates a
traffic hazard or is obstructing traffic and the vehicle may
be safely moved. A vehicle may also be moved by the driver of
