SB167 1 2 3 4 ENROLLED, An Act, To amend Section 34-24-604, Code of Alabama 1975, 5 relating to annual registrations and fees for physicians 6 providing pain management services for physician practice 7 8 locations; to provide that each such physician shall pay one registration fee or annual renewal fee with no additional fee 9 for additional practice locations. 10 11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: Section 1. Section 34-24-604, Code of Alabama 1975, 12 13 is amended to read as follows: "\$34-24-604. 14 15 "(a) Beginning January 1, 2014, and continuing each 16 year thereafter: "(1) All physicians providing pain management 17 18 services shall obtain a pain management registration from the 19 board. 20 "(2) All physicians who otherwise meet the criteria 21 established by the board shall obtain a pain management 22 registration from the board. 23 "(b) To register, a physician applicant shall submit 24 the following to the board:

1 "(1) A completed application on a form prescribed by 2 the board.

3 "(2) Proof of a current drug enforcement
4 administration registration.

5 "(3) Proof of an Alabama controlled substances6 certificate.

7 "(4) Proof of a current registration with the
8 Alabama Prescription Drug Monitoring Program.

9 "(5) A list of all registrants who own, co-own, 10 operate, or provide pain management services in the practice 11 location.

12 "(6) The disclosure of any controlled substances 13 certificate or registration denial, restriction, or discipline 14 imposed on the registrant, or any disciplinary act against the 15 license of the registrant.

16 "(7) Payment of the initial registration fee as set 17 forth in this section and in the rules of the Alabama Board of 18 Medical Examiners.

"(8) A certification listing the current name of thephysician who will serve as the medical director.

"(9) Any other information requested by the board related to the qualifications to, or the provision of, providing pain management services.

24 "(c) The applicant shall provide the board with a25 physical address for each location where he or she provides

1	pain management services and a list of all physicians who work
2	at the practice location, including the name of the physician
3	who will serve as the medical director. For purposes of this
4	subsection, if a practice location is a hospital, the
5	physician applicant is not required to provide the names of
6	physicians at the hospital other than the medical director.
7	"(d) Exemptions. The provisions of this article
8	shall not apply to any of the following:
9	"(1) A hospice program licensed by the Alabama
10	Department of Public Health, or any physicians while
11	performing work for that program.
12	"(2) A facility maintained or operated by the United
13	States or any of its departments, offices, or agencies, or any
14	physicians while performing work for that facility.
15	"(e) The board shall provide individual, entity, and
16	any categorical exemptions as, in its discretion, it deems
17	appropriate.
18	"(f) Any physician who is not included in
19	subdivisions (1) and (2) of subsection (d) may petition the
20	board for an exemption from the requirements of this section
21	for working at a particular entity. The board shall have the
22	sole discretion in determining whether the requested exemption
23	shall be granted or denied.
24	"(g) Fees.

"(1) An initial registration fee is provided in an 1 2 amount set by the board in its rules not to exceed three 3 hundred dollars (\$300). "(2) Renewal fee. A renewal fee is provided in an 4 5 amount set by the board in its rules not to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300). 6 "(3) There shall be no initial registration fee or 7 8 renewal fee for additional practice locations. "(h) Miscellaneous. 9 10 "(1) An applicant practicing in more than one location shall submit a separate registration fee for each 11 12 practice. 13 "(2) (1) If an applicant does not complete the 14 initial application process within 90 days of his or her first 15 submission to the board, then the application shall be closed, 16 the application fee shall not be refunded, and the applicant 17 shall be required to reapply for registration. 18 "(3) (2) An application which is submitted to the board may be withdrawn at any time prior to the granting or 19 denial of registration; provided, however, that the 20 21 application fee shall not be refunded. 22 "(i) Renewal. 23 "(1) A registration by a physician under this 24 article shall expire on December 31 of each year.

"(2) A registrant may renew a current registration prior to its expiration date by submitting the following to the board: "a. A renewal application form prescribed by the board. "b. The required renewal fee. "c. A certification that each location at which the applicant provides pain management service has a medical director. "d. If the practice location is not a hospital, an attestation that the practice location is not owned wholly or partly by a person who has been convicted of or pled nolo contendre to any of the following: "1. A felony. "2. An offense that constitutes a misdemeanor, the facts of which relate to the distribution or illegal prescription of any controlled substance. "e. Any applicant who has been convicted of a crime described in paragraph d. may request an interview before the board, after which the board may approve or deny the registration. "f. Any other information requested by the board." Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and

25 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
