4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to the State Personnel Board; to amend  
6 Section 36-6-6, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide that the  
7 salaries of cabinet members, assistant cabinet members,  
8 assistant department heads, and other officers and employees  
9 appointed in the exempt service shall be fixed in accordance  
10 with recommendations by the State Personnel Board of  
11 appropriate pay ranges within the state pay plan.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

13 Section 1. Section 36-6-6, Code of Alabama 1975, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 "§36-6-6.

16 "(a) Unless otherwise fixed by law, the salaries of  
17 appointed department heads or those otherwise considered  
18 members of the Governor's cabinet, ~~shall be fixed by the~~  
19 ~~Governor at an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00 per annum;~~ the  
20 salaries of the appointed assistant department heads or those  
21 otherwise considered as the Governor's assistant cabinet  
22 members, ~~shall be fixed by the Governor at an amount not to~~  
23 ~~exceed \$30,000.00 per annum~~ and the salaries of other officers  
24 and employees appointed in the exempt service and the  
25 executive assistants in the Governor's office shall be fixed

1 by the Governor ~~at an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 per~~  
2 ~~annum; provided, that where~~ in accordance with the  
3 recommendations by the State Personnel Board of appropriate  
4 pay ranges within the state pay plan.

5 "(b) Where some authority other than the Governor  
6 appoints such an officer or employee, the salary shall be  
7 fixed by the appointing authority with the approval of the  
8 Governor and the State Personnel Board.

9 "(c) In fixing such salaries, the Governor or other  
10 appointing authority shall give due consideration to the  
11 salaries of comparable positions in other states and in  
12 private industry in Alabama."

13 Section 2. This act shall become effective October  
14 1, 2015 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
15 its otherwise becoming law.
