25	an employing board, as defined in Section 16-24B-2, Code of
26	Alabama 1975, may hire an assistant principal, on or after
27	July 1, 2015, through a performance-based contract, and an

assistant principal hired as such, shall be subject to the
same employment practices as those for contract principals
under Sections 16-24B-3, 16-24B-3.1, 16-24B-5, and 16-24B-6,
Code of Alabama 1975.

Section 2. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
