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8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, principals of public
9 schools hired on or after July 1, 2000, are
10 employed through performance-based contracts.

11 This bill would authorize public school
12 systems to hire assistant principals through
13 performance-based contracts in a manner similar to
14 principals.

20 Relating to school principals; to authorize public
21 school systems to hire assistant principals through
22 performance-based contracts in a manner similar to principals.
23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,
25 an employing board, as defined in Section 16-24B-2, Code of
26 Alabama 1975, may hire an assistant principal, on or after
27 July 1, 2015, through a performance-based contract, and an

1 assistant principal hired as such, shall be subject to the
2 same employment practices as those for contract principals
3 under Sections 16-24B-3, 16-24B-3.1, 16-24B-5, and 16-24B-6,
4 Code of Alabama 1975.

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective
6 immediately following its passage and approval by the
7 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
