19	Section 1. Sections 40-18-320, 40-18-321, and

23	"This article shall be known and may be cited as the
24	"Heroes for Hire" Tax Credit Act of 2012 Veterans Employment

1	"(a) In addition to the existing tax credit allowed		
2	for in the Full Employment Act of 2011, codified as Section		
3	<u>Sections</u> 40-18-290 through 40-18-293, an additional \$1,000 tax		
4	credit for job creation is available if existing requirements		
5	of Section <u>Sections</u> 40-18-290 through 40-18-293 are met along		
6	with the following definition:		
7	"RECENTLY DEPLOYED UNEMPLOYED VETERAN. An individual		
8	who is all of the following:		
9	"(1) Was a resident of Alabama at the time of entry		
10	into military service or was mobilized to active, federal		
11	military service while a member of the Alabama National Guard		
12	or other reserve unit located in Alabama, regardless of the		
13	resident's home of record.		
14	"(2) Received an honorable or general discharge from		
15	active, federal military service within the two-year period		
16	preceding the date of hire.		
17	"(3) Has certification by the Department of Labor at		
18	the time of hire of either of the following:		
19	"a. Collecting or being eligible to collect

"For all tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2012 2016, a qualified employer subject to the requirements of this article and Section Sections 40-18-290 through 40-18-293, shall be eligible for an additional nonrefundable credit against the income tax liability imposed or the state portion of the financial institution excise tax owed in an amount equal to \$1,000 one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each new full-time recently deployed unemployed veteran hired after the passage of this article for a position, the majority of the duties of which are at a business location within Alabama."
