5	To amend Sections 16-51-3 and 16-51-4, Code of
6	Alabama 1975, relating to the Board of Trustees of the
7	University of North Alabama (UNA); to provide further for the
8	terms of office for board members of UNA, emergency meetings
9	of the board, and meetings of the board by teleconferencing.
10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
11	Section 1. Sections 16-51-3 and 16-51-4, Code of
12	Alabama 1975, is hereby amended to read as follows:
13	" §16-51-3.
14	"There is hereby created a Board of Trustees for the
15	University of North Alabama, the state educational institution
16	at Florence, Alabama. The board of trustees shall consist of
17	six members who are residents of the seventh and eighth
18	congressional districts, at least two of whom shall be
19	residents of the county in which the institution is located,
20	and three members from the state at large, the State
21	Superintendent of Education and the Governor, who shall be ex
22	officio president of the board. The trustees shall be
23	appointed by the Governor, by and with the advice and consent
24	of the Senate and, except for the first trustees appointed,

shall hold office for a term of 12 years, until 2015, and

1	until their successors shall be appointed and qualified. The
2	Governor shall coordinate his or her appointments so that
3	diversity of gender, race, and geographical areas is
4	reflective of the makeup of this state. The board shall be
5	divided into three classes, as nearly equal as may be, so that
6	one third may be chosen quadrennially. Of the first members
7	appointed to the board, one third shall be appointed for terms
8	of four years, one third for terms of eight years and one
9	third for terms of 12 years. Beginning in 2015, the board
10	shall be divided into three groups, so that reappointments may
11	be made each two years. In 2015, three members shall be
12	appointed for terms of two years, and three members shall be
13	appointed for terms of four years, and three members shall be
14	appointed for terms of six years. Thereafter, all successor
15	members shall be appointed for six-year terms. A trustee may
16	be reappointed to additional terms. No trustee shall receive
17	any pay or emolument other than his actual expenses incurred
18	in the discharge of his duties as such. No employee of the
19	university shall be eligible to serve on its board of
20	trustees.

"(a) The Board of Trustees of the University of
North Alabama shall hold its regular annual meeting each year
at the university on the first Monday in June, unless the
board shall, in regular session, determine to hold its

1	meetings at some other time and place. The board may establish
2	a schedule of meetings at such intervals as it deems
3	appropriate and may amend the schedule at any duly called
4	meeting. Special meetings of the board may be assembled by
5	either one of the two methods outlined as follows:

2.1

- "(1) Special meetings of the board may be called by the Governor. In calling such special meetings the Governor shall mail a written notice to each trustee at least 10 days in advance of the date of such meetings.
- "(2) Upon the application in writing of any three members of the board, the Governor shall call a special meeting, naming the time and place thereof and causing notices to be issued in writing to the several members of the board. Such meetings shall not be held on a date less than 10 days subsequent to the notice from the Governor.
- "(3) An emergency meeting of the board may be called when circumstances exist that are deemed by the Governor or by the president pro tempore or by three members of the board to present a risk to personal health, safety, or property or to the operation of the university. The three board members must communicate their request for an emergency meeting to the Governor or to the president pro tempore by the most expedient means available to them. Notice of an emergency meeting should be given at least 72 hours prior to the time it is to commence

1 unless the circumstances of the emergency are such that the
2 meeting must convene sooner.

"(b) Members of the Board of Trustees of the University of North Alabama may participate in a meeting of the board or any committee by means of telephone conference, video conference, or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting may hear each other at the same time. Participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at a meeting for all purposes. However, a majority of a quorum of the members of the board of trustees, or, in the event of a meeting of only the executive committee, a majority of a quorum of the executive committee of the board of trustees must be physically present at the location noticed and called for the meeting in order to conduct any business or deliberation. Members of the board of trustees and any committees of the board of trustees may not utilize electronic communications except as in compliance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act. Except for emergency meetings, notice of board meetings shall be provided in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act and telephone or video conference or similar communications equipment shall also allow members of the public the opportunity to simultaneously listen to or observe such meetings."
