14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the
16	following terms shall have the following meanings:
17	(1) AUTHORIZER. An entity authorized under Act
18	2015-3, 2015 Regular Session to review applications, approve
19	or reject applications, enter into charter contracts with
20	applicants, oversee public charter schools, and decide whether
21	to renew, not renew, or revoke charter contracts.
22	(2) CHARTER CONTRACT. A fixed-term renewable
23	contract between a public charter school and an authorizer
24	that outlines the roles, powers, responsibilities, and

quantitative and qualitative performance expectations for each

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party to the contract.

1 (3) COMMISSION. The Alabama Public Charter School Commission.

- (4) INTERNAL PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL. A public school selected by the local school board to operate as a public charter school within the local school system.
 - (5) LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD. A city or county board of education exercising management and control of a city or county local school system pursuant to state law.
 - (b) Commencing with the 2016-2017 school year, each local school board in the state may select a school within the jurisdiction of the local school system to operate as an internal public charter school pursuant to a pilot program. The pilot program shall continue for a period of five school years and shall end with the 2020-2021 school year, unless extended by legislative action.
 - (c) An internal public charter school participating in the pilot program shall have the same flexibility, and operate under the same rules, as a public charter school established pursuant to Act 2015-3, 2015 Regular Session, except that an internal public charter school is not required to enter into a charter contract with an authorizer. The local school board shall be responsible for the day to day oversight of the internal public charter school.
 - (d) Each internal public charter school, through the local school board, shall annually report to the State

 Department of Education regarding student achievement, student growth by newly enrolled students and continuing students, and

- any other information as determined necessary by the

 department. The department shall compile a comprehensive

 report for all internal public charter schools operating in

 the state and shall annually submit the comprehensive report

 to the commission before December 15 each year.
 - (e) The commission shall issue an annual report on the progress of the internal public charter school pilot program to the Legislature and the Governor on or before the tenth legislative day of the regular session.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.

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
