9 A BILL  
10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT

13 Relating to the City of Vestavia Hills located in  
14 parts of Shelby and Jefferson Counties; to provide for a  
15 warrant recall fee to allow a municipal magistrate or  
16 municipal judge for the City of Vestavia Hills to recall,  
17 under certain conditions, a failure to appear warrant.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the  
20 contrary, a municipal judge or municipal magistrate of the  
21 City of Vestavia Hills, Alabama, may assess a defendant with a  
22 warrant recall fee that shall be paid in order for a municipal  
23 judge or magistrate to recall a failure to appear warrant  
24 arising from any municipal ordinance violation against the  
25 City of Vestavia Hills.

1                   (b) The warrant recall fee shall be one hundred  
2 dollars (\$100) and is to be paid by the defendant at the time  
3 the warrant is recalled.

4                   (c) Nothing herein shall be construed to require the  
5 City of Vestavia Hills to recall a warrant that has been  
6 issued. All orders to recall a warrant shall be issued solely  
7 in the discretion of the municipal judge or magistrate.

8                   Section 2. All fees received by the City of Vestavia  
9 Hills Municipal Court for the warrant recall fee shall be  
10 deposited into the City of Vestavia Hills Corrections Fund and  
11 allocated in conformity with subsection (a) of Section  
12 11-47-7.1 of the Code of Alabama 1975.

13                   Section 3. The provisions of this act are severable.  
14 If any part of this act is declared invalid or  
15 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part  
16 which remains.

17                   Section 4. This act shall become effective  
18 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
