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21	Relating to schools; to amend Section 16-27-1, Code
22	of Alabama 1975, to authorize local boards of education to set
23	policies providing for the transportation of students to and
24	from extracurricular activities by modes of transportation
25	other than bus.
26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 16-27-1, Code of Alabama 1975, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: "\$16-27-1. 3 "(a) The State Board of Education shall prescribe 5 rules and regulations: "(1) Requiring all local boards of education which 6 7 provide transportation services for pupils going to and from public elementary and secondary schools of Alabama or in 8 school-related activities, and the presidents of all state 9 10 community, junior and technical colleges and directors of all state technical institutes and trade schools which provide 11 12 transportation services for pupils going to and from said 13 technical institutes and trade schools or community, junior 14 and technical colleges to employ a competent supervisor or manager of such transportation services, whether such 15 transportation services are provided in publicly owned or 16 17 privately owned buses; "(2) Requiring periodic safety inspection of all 18 vehicles used for transporting pupils, whether such vehicles 19 20 are publicly or privately owned; 21 "(3) Requiring and providing for special training 22 and licensing of drivers of all vehicles used to transport 23 pupils to and from school and in all school-related 24 activities, whether such vehicles are publicly owned and 25 operated or operated under contract with a private owner. 26 "(b) Nothing in this section shall prevent local

boards of education from implementing policies for the

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1	transportation of students to and from extracurricular
2	activities that does not require the use of a school bus,
3	provided that the policies include all of the following:
4	"(1) Provisions addressing how the students may be
5	transported and who is authorized to transport students.
6	"(2) That written consent of the parent or legal
7	guardian of the student is required.
8	"(3) That private vehicles may only be used if they
9	are lawfully registered, properly maintained, and properly
10	insured.
11	"(4) That drivers of private vehicles must be
12	lawfully licensed and that it is mandatory that the driver
13	strictly adheres to all motor vehicle laws and rules of the
14	road."
15	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
16	first day of the third month following its passage and
17	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
