24	Section 1. (a) Any person who owns a condominium or
25	attached housing shall maintain property insurance insuring
26	against all risks of direct physical loss commonly insured
27	against. The total amount of insurance after application of

any deductible shall not be less than 150 percent of the actual cash value of the insured property at the time the insurance is purchased.

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(b) Any person who owns a condominium or attached housing shall maintain liability insurance, including medical payments insurance, covering all occurrences commonly insured against for death, bodily injury, and property damage, arising out of or in connection with the use, ownership, or maintenance of any common element of the housing.

Section 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2016.
