16	ten dollars (\$10) on each motor vehicle registration in the
17	county. This issuance fee shall be in addition to all other
18	charges, costs, taxes, or fees levied on the issuance of all
19	annual motor vehicle registrations.
20	(b) Those persons exempt from paying ad valorem
21	taxes under Section 40-9-21, Code of Alabama 1975, are exempt
22	from the annual issuance fee authorized by this act for one
23	motor vehicle per year.
24	Section 3. The annual issuance fee shall become due
25	at the same time the state license and registration fee

becomes due pursuant to Section 32-6-61, Code of Alabama 1975, provided the fee shall not be collected more than once in a 12-month period per motor vehicle.

Section 4. (a) The county commission may adopt and promulgate rules necessary for the collection and enforcement of the issuance fee authorized by this act and may expend proceeds from the fees as may be necessary to collect and enforce the issuance fee.

- (b) The remaining proceeds shall be distributed as followings:
- (1) Forty percent of the proceeds from the fee authorized by this act shall be deposited into the general fund of the City of Phenix City to be used for the building, repair, and maintenance of roads, bridges, and sidewalks located within the corporate limits of Phenix City.
- authorized by this act shall be deposited into the county general fund to be expended at the discretion of the county commission. Of this amount, the county commission may deposit a percentage of the proceeds deposited in the county general fund in the general fund of the City of Hurtsboro to be used for the building, repair, and maintenance of roads, bridges, and sidewalks located within the corporate limits of the City of Hurtsboro.
