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6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 Relating to Russell County; authorizing the county
8 commission to levy an additional issuance fee on motor vehicle
9 registrations; and to provide for the use of the proceeds.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. This act shall apply only to Russell
12 County.

13 Section 2. (a) The County Commission of Russell
14 County, upon the adoption of a resolution by a recorded roll
15 call vote, may levy an additional annual issuance fee of up to
16 ten dollars (\$10) on each motor vehicle registration in the
17 county. This issuance fee shall be in addition to all other
18 charges, costs, taxes, or fees levied on the issuance of all
19 annual motor vehicle registrations.

20 (b) Those persons exempt from paying ad valorem
21 taxes under Section 40-9-21, Code of Alabama 1975, are exempt
22 from the annual issuance fee authorized by this act for one
23 motor vehicle per year.

24 Section 3. The annual issuance fee shall become due
25 at the same time the state license and registration fee

1 becomes due pursuant to Section 32-6-61, Code of Alabama 1975,
2 provided the fee shall not be collected more than once in a
3 12-month period per motor vehicle.

4 Section 4. (a) The county commission may adopt and
5 promulgate rules necessary for the collection and enforcement
6 of the issuance fee authorized by this act and may expend
7 proceeds from the fees as may be necessary to collect and
8 enforce the issuance fee.

9 (b) The remaining proceeds shall be distributed as
10 followings:

11 (1) Forty percent of the proceeds from the fee
12 authorized by this act shall be deposited into the general
13 fund of the City of Phenix City to be used for the building,
14 repair, and maintenance of roads, bridges, and sidewalks
15 located within the corporate limits of Phenix City.

16 (2) Sixty percent of the proceeds from the fee
17 authorized by this act shall be deposited into the county
18 general fund to be expended at the discretion of the county
19 commission. Of this amount, the county commission may deposit
20 a percentage of the proceeds deposited in the county general
21 fund in the general fund of the City of Hurtsboro to be used
22 for the building, repair, and maintenance of roads, bridges,
23 and sidewalks located within the corporate limits of the City
24 of Hurtsboro.

1 Section 5. This act shall become effective January
2 1, 2016, upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
3 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
