Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the retirement benefits received by a person who has retired from the Teachers' Retirement System or the Employees' Retirement System may not be affected because the person is employed as a school resource officer.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
