SB455 1 2 3 ENROLLED, An Act, 4 To amend Section 9-12-46, Code of Alabama 1975, 5 relating to the commercial harvesting of shrimp, to authorize 6 the Commissioner of the Department of Conservation and Natural 7 8 Resources to establish areas that are closed for commercial and recreational harvesting of shrimp; to allow the 9 10 commissioner to provide for emergency open and closed seasons for the harvesting of shrimp; and in connection therewith 11 would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new 12 13 or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of 14 Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now 15 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended. 16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 17 18 Section 1. Section 9-12-46, Code of Alabama 1975, is 19 amended to read as follows: "§9-12-46. 20 21 "(a) The Commissioner of Conservation and Natural 22 Resources shall set by regulation the minimum weight 23 requirement of shrimp which are caught or taken from the 24 territorial waters of Alabama for commercial purposes or which 25 are brought into Alabama from waters beyond the territorial

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jurisdiction of Alabama for commercial purposes; provided, 1 2 however, that such minimum weight requirement as set by regulation of said Commissioner of Conservation and Natural 3 Resources shall require not more than 68 shrimp with heads 4 5 attached to weigh one pound and shall require not more than 114 headless shrimp to the pound rule areas that are closed 6 for commercial and recreational shrimping subject to the 7 8 restrictions provided in subsection (b). "It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, 9 10 corporation or association to sell, offer for sale or have in possession for sale for commercial purposes any shrimp which 11 require more in number to weigh one pound than the number per 12 13 pound as set by regulation of the Commissioner of Conservation 14 and Natural Resources. "(b)(1) All inside waters, as defined by rules 15 16 adopted by the Commissioner of the Department of Conservation 17 and Natural Resources, shall be closed to all commercial and 18 recreational shrimping from 6:00 a.m., May 1, to 6:00 a.m., 19 June 1 of each year. "(2) The portion of Mobile Bay that lies within the 20 described area from Mayday Park to Great Point Clear, as 21 22 defined by rule, shall be closed to commercial and 23 recreational shrimping from 6:00 a.m., August 15, until 6:00 a.m. October 1 of each year. 24

1	"(c) The commissioner may provide for emergency open
2	or closed seasons for the taking of shrimp due to biological,
3	technical, or environmental factors or for the protection of
4	public health and welfare.
5	" <u>(d)</u> Any person, firm, corporation or association
6	who or which violates any of the provisions of this section
7	shall be guilty of a <u>Class C</u> misdemeanor and, upon conviction,
8	shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more
9	than \$100.00 for each offense, punishable as provided by law.
10	" <u>(e)</u> Nothing in this section shall be construed to
11	apply to shrimp which are used solely as bait."
12	Section 2. Any shrimp harvested from inland ponds or
13	farms may be processed at the site where the harvesting occurs
14	pursuant to rules adopted by the Alabama Department of Public
15	Health.
16	Section 3. Although this bill would have as its
17	purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased
18	expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further
19	requirements and application under Amendment 621, now
20	appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of
21	the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the
22	bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an
23	existing crime.

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Section 4. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
