25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Section 22-20-4.1 is added to the Code of
27	Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

1 \$22-20-4.1.

In the event body fluids or suspected bodily fluids, leak onto the surface from any source where human remains are interred, the county board of health may take whatever action it deems necessary to inspect the area and require the responsible person to abate the leakage, including, but not limited to, bringing an action for injunctive relief in a court of competent jurisdiction. The Department of Public Health may promulgate rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to implement and administer this section.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
