8	SYNOPSIS:	This bill would prohibit the use, delivery,
9		sale, or manufacture of nitrous oxide cartridges in
10		this state, would provide criminal penalties for

13		Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama
14		of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the
15		Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
16		Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general
17		law whose purpose or effect would be to require a
18		new or increased expenditure of local funds from
19		becoming effective with regard to a local
20		governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote
21		unless: it comes within one of a number of
22		specified exceptions; it is approved by the
23		affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates
24		funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to
25		the entity for the purpose.
26		The purpose or effect of this bill would be
27		to require a new or increased expenditure of local

funds within the meaning of the amendment. However,

the bill does not require approval of a local

governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to

become effective because it comes within one of the

specified exceptions contained in the amendment.

8 TO BE ENTITLED

9 AN ACT

Relating to nitrous oxide; to prohibit the use, delivery, sale, or manufacture of nitrous oxide cartridges; to provide criminal penalties; to provide for the forfeiture of the nitrous oxide cartridges; and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the term "nitrous oxide cartridge" means a cartridge, charger, or canister that contains food grade or pharmaceutical grade nitrous oxide as a principal ingredient.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to use, deliver, or sell, possess with intent to deliver or sell, or

- 1 manufacture with intent to deliver or sell, or to possess with 2 intent to use, a nitrous oxide cartridge.
- 3 (c) A nitrous oxide cartridge used in violation of 4 this section shall be contraband and subject to the forfeiture 5 laws of this state.

(d) A violation of subsection (b) shall be a Class B misdemeanor.

Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
