This bill requires a resolution to adopt a 14 15 salary or expense allowance increase for members of 16 a city council to be introduced 30 days prior to the date the council takes final action on the 17 18 resolution. 19 20 A BILL 21 TO BE ENTITLED 22 AN ACT 23 24 Relating city councils, to require a resolution to 25 adopt a salary or expense allowance increase for members of a 26 city council to be introduced 30 days prior to the date the council takes final action on the resolution. 27

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. Sections 11-40-14 and 11-43-7.2, Code of 3 Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

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"§11-40-14.

"(a) The council or other governing body of Class 1 5 municipalities in Alabama and all municipalities in Alabama 6 7 having a population of 250,000 or more according to the last and any subsequent federal decennial census, shall have the 8 power and authority to grant to any member of such council or 9 10 other governing body an amount of money for expenses incurred 11 by such member on account of such member's attending the 12 business of such municipality within its corporate limits. The 13 maximum expense allowance shall be \$300.00 per month for each member of the council, except the president or chairman of the 14 15 council or other governing body who may be given an allowance 16 not to exceed \$350.00 per month.

17 "(b) In addition to the authority granted by 18 subsection (a) of this section, the council or other governing 19 body of Class 1 municipalities in Alabama and all 20 municipalities in Alabama having a population of 250,000 or more according to the last and any subsequent federal 21 22 decennial census commencing November 15, 1983, shall have the 23 power and authority to grant to any member of such council or 24 other governing body who was elected for a term commencing in 25 November, 1981, an amount of money in addition to that 26 provided in subsection (a) of this section, for expenses 27 incurred by such member on account of such member's attending

the business of such municipality within its corporate limits.
The maximum additional expense allowance shall be \$200.00 per
month for each such member of the council. No such additional
expense allowance shall be paid to any council member after
November 15, 1985.

6 "(c) The provisions of this section shall not be 7 construed so as to prevent any such member of such council or 8 other governing body from being reimbursed for actual expenses 9 incurred by him on or in connection with a trip on municipal 10 business beyond the corporate limits of such municipality, 11 which amount shall not accrue against the monetary amounts 12 provided in subsection (a) of this section.

13 "(d) An increase in salary for city council members 14 must be approved by a resolution of the city council body, in 15 which the resolution to adopt the increase must be introduced 16 <u>30 days prior to the date the council takes final action on</u> 17 <u>the resolution.</u>

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"§11-43-7.2.

19 "(a) In addition to the authority granted by Section 20 11-43-7.1, the council or other governing body of any Class 1 21 municipality may grant to the members of the council or 22 governing body, an additional amount of money monthly for 23 expenses incurred by the members when attending to the 24 business of the municipality within its corporate limits. The 25 maximum amount of the additional expense allowance shall be 26 three hundred thirty-three dollars and thirty-three cents (\$333.33) per month and shall be approved by a resolution of 27

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the city council body, in which the resolution to adopt the increase must be introduced 30 days prior to the date the council takes final action on the resolution.

"(b) Notwithstanding all other provisions of law, 4 5 any council or governing body member may elect in writing to have the expense allowances authorized by subsection (a) of 6 7 this section and Section 11-43-7.1, become subject to the 8 withholding of any employee contribution required to be paid 9 into the trust fund of any pension or retirement system in 10 which the member is eligible to participate. A council or 11 governing body member may also elect in writing, within 90 12 days of May 4, 1994, to pay into the pension or retirement 13 system trust fund the required contribution on any expense allowances previously received by the member during all or any 14 15 portion of the three-year period prior to the member's payment 16 election, together with interest at the rate of eight percent 17 per annum thereon computed from the date of receipt of the allowance to the date of payment. If either or both of the 18 19 elections is made by a member of the governing body or 20 council, the expense allowances on which employee 21 contributions are paid into the retirement plan trust fund 22 shall be considered together with all salaries received by the 23 member, from which the required employee contribution was 24 likewise withheld and paid into the retirement trust fund, to 25 determine the base amount on which any retirement benefits or 26 allowances to which the council or governing body member may

be entitled shall be computed as provided under the retirement system.

"(c) The provisions of this section shall not be 3 4 construed to prevent any member of the council or governing 5 body from being reimbursed for actual expenses incurred by the member in connection with any travel on municipal business 6 7 beyond the corporate limits of the municipality, and the amount incurred shall not accrue against the monetary amounts 8 provided in subsection (a) of this section, nor shall the 9 10 reimbursement for the amount incurred be eligible for pension 11 system withholding or be considered in determining pension or retirement benefits or allowances." 12

Section 2. Section 11-43-67 is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

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"§11-43-67.

"For any class of municipality, an increase in salary or expense allowance for city council members must be approved by a resolution of the city council body, in which the resolution to adopt the increase must be introduced 30 days prior to the date the council takes final action on the resolution."

22 Section 3. Any increase in salary or expense 23 allowance which was approved prior to the passage of this act, 24 but which has not yet taken effect is void if it was adopted 25 in a manner that was inconsistent with the requirements of 26 this act. Section 4. This act shall become effective
 immediately following its passage and approval by the
 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
