11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Conecuh County; to provide for the
14 appointment of the county superintendent of education; and to
15 repeal Act 163, 1923 Regular Session (Local Acts 1923, p. 79)
16 and Act 524, 1959 Regular Session (Acts 1959, p. 1300).

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. (a) The Conecuh County Board of Education
19 shall appoint the Superintendent of Education of Conecuh
20 County pursuant to the general law of the state. The county
21 superintendent of education shall possess all the
22 qualifications prescribed for county superintendents of
23 education by the general laws of the state.

24 (b) The Superintendent of Education of Conecuh
25 County shall hold office for a term of four years. Vacancies
26 in the office of Superintendent of Education of Conecuh County

1 shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment of the
2 board of education.

3 (c) This section shall apply at the expiration of
4 the term of office of the current county superintendent of
5 education or upon any vacancy occurring in the office of the
6 county superintendent of education before the expiration of
7 his or her current term of office.

8 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
9 with this act are repealed, and Act 163, 1923 Regular Session
10 (Local Acts 1923, p. 79) and Act 524, 1959 Regular Session
11 (Acts 1959, p. 1300), are specifically repealed.

12 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
13 first day of the third month following its passage and
14 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
