- (a) The owner of an auction business or business of auctioneering shall maintain a correct record of all goods sold at auction for more than one hundred dollars (\$100).
- (b) The owner of an auction business or business of auctioneering shall make available to the appropriate law enforcement agency a correct record of the transactions described in subsection (a) of this section.
- (c) An owner who willfully violates this section and upon conviction of a violation shall be punished by a fine not in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each violation.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
