or when any state employee who is a parent of a deceased law 1 2 enforcement officer is requested by the district attorney or Attorney General to be present, for the trial of a defendant 3 charged with a criminal homicide in the death of the law 4 enforcement officer in the line of duty, the state employee 5 shall be granted administrative leave with pay for any time 6 7 the employee is required to be off from work to attend the trial. 8

9 Section 2. This act shall be retroactive to January 10 1, 2013.
