- 2 Section 1. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), a state employee hired on or after the effective date of this 3 act shall participate in the direct deposit of the employee's wages.
 - (b) An employee may not be required to participate in the direct deposit of his or her wages under subsection (a) if he or she does not have an account at a financial institution in which wages may be directly deposited.
 - (c) The State Personnel Department shall do all of the following:
 - (1) Provide agencies and departments of the state with an electronic fund transfer authorization form to provide to employees.
 - (2) Deposit the wages of a state employee into a personal account at a financial institution selected by the employee on the electronic fund transfer authorization form.
 - (3) Each time the board pays the wages of a state employee by direct deposit, provide the employee with a direct deposit statement that includes all of the following:
 - a. The total amount of the wages.
 - b. Any amount deducted from the wages.
 - c. The amount of the wages directly deposited into the personal bank account selected by the employee.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
