Section 1. The following amendment to the
Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and
shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a
majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in
accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution
of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

The State of Alabama, it officers, agencies, and 9 10 employees are prohibited from transferring, using, or pledging 11 any monies currently designated by law and deposited into a 12 public account for use by the state parks system or any entity of the state parks system and any monies generated by the 13 14 state parks through fees or charges from being transferred to another public account or entity and used for any purpose 15 other than the support, upkeep, and maintenance of the state 16 17 parks system.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

24 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 25 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 26 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the

following description of the substance or subject matter of 1 2 the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 3 4 Alabama of 1901, to prohibit any monies currently designated pursuant to statute for the use of the state parks system and 5 any monies generated by the state parks from being transferred 6 7 for another purpose or drawn upon the General Fund for any other purpose other than the support, upkeep, and maintenance 8 of the state parks system. 9
