3 Relating to Randolph County; to authorize the county commission to enact a noise ordinance in the areas outside the 4 5 corporate limits of a municipality; and outside the boundaries of any industrial park designated by the county pursuant to 6 Sections 11-23-1 to 11-23-8, inclusive, of the Code of Alabama 7 8 1975 and to provide that a violation of the ordinance constitutes a public nuisance subject to civil penalties. 9 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. In Randolph County, the county commission 12 may enact a noise ordinance for the areas outside of the 13 corporate limits of a municipality and outside the boundaries 14 of any industrial park designated by the county pursuant to 15 Sections 11-23-1 to 11-23-8, inclusive, of the Code of Alabama 16 1975, and may provide that a violation of the ordinance 17 constitutes a public nuisance subject to a civil fine of not 18 more than \$250 to be assessed as provided in the ordinance. 19 Any law enforcement officer or constable may issue a citation 20 alleging a violation of the ordinance. The ordinance may 21 provide that the person charged with a violation may pay a 22 civil fine or request, within 30 days of receipt of the 23 citation, a due process hearing before the county commission 24 or its hearing officer on the validity of the citation. An 25 order of the county commission finding a violation and an

1 assessment of a civil fine shall be final within 30 days thereof unless appealed to the Circuit Court in Randolph 2 3 County based on the administrative record of the hearing. Any 4 fine due and owing shall be considered a debt owed to the 5 Randolph County Commission and shall be enforceable by civil action in the same manner as any other debt. The person owing 6 the fine shall be liable for all costs, including court costs 7 8 and attorney fees, and all other expenses of litigation if action is taken to collect the fine owed. 9

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
