3	To amend Section 16-28-3, Code of Alabama 1975,			
4	relating to school attendance; to require any child who			
5	withdraws from a public school to enroll in and attend an			
6	accredited online school to be counted as a transfer student;			
7	and to require grade placement testing for any student who			
8	later returns to a public school.			
9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:			
10	Section 1. This bill does not and should not be			
11	interpreted to create on-line schools. However, if a student			
12	chooses to attend an accredited, state authorized on-line			
13	school, that student's former school should not be penalized			
14	by the student being classified as a dropout.			
15	Section 2. Section 16-28-3, Code of Alabama 1975, is			
16	amended to read as follows:			
17	"§16-28-3.			
18	" <del>Every</del> <u>(a) Except as otherwise provided in</u>			
19	subsection (b), every child between the ages of six and 17			
20	years shall be required to attend a public school, private			
21	school, church school, or be instructed by a competent private			
22	tutor for the entire length of the school term in every			
23	scholastic year except that, prior to attaining his or her			
24	16th birthday every child attending a church school as defined			
25	in Section 16-28-1 is exempt from the requirements of this			

section, provided such child complies with enrollment and 1 reporting procedure specified in Section 16-28-7. Admission to 2 3 public school shall be on an individual basis on the application of the parents, legal custodian, or quardian of 4 the child to the local board of education at the beginning of 5 each school year, under such rules and regulations as the 6 board may prescribe. The parent, legal custodian, or quardian 7 8 of a child who is six years of age, may opt out of enrolling their child in school at the age of six years by notifying the 9 local school board of education, in writing, that the child 10 11 will not be enrolled in school until he or she is seven years 12 of age.

13 "(b) If a child withdraws from a public school, upon 14 verification of enrollment in an a Southern Association of 15 Colleges and Schools or any entity with accreditation status 16 as determined by one of the agencies identified on the United 17 States Department of Education's list of Recognized National 18 and Regional Accrediting Agencies or their affiliates 19 accredited and recognized online school which has been authorized by the Alabama State Department of Education to 20 21 provide instruction in lieu of in-person instruction, the 22 child shall be counted as a transfer student. 23 "(c) If a child returns to a public school, semester exams shall be given to the child to determine grade 24 25 placement."

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Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
