2 "(a) Judgments for the payment of money, other than costs, if based upon a contract action, bear interest from the 3 4 day of the cause of action, at the same rate of interest as stated in the contract a rate of 21 percent per annum, unless 5 a lower rate is set forth in the contract; all other judgments 6 7 shall bear interest from the date the judgment is signed at the rate of 7.5 percent per annum, the provisions of Section 8 8-8-1 to the contrary notwithstanding; provided, that fees 9 10 allowed a trustee, executor, administrator, or attorney and taxed as a part of the cost of the proceeding shall bear 11 12 interest at a like rate from the day of entry.

"(b) This section shall apply to all judgmentsentered on and after September 1, 2011."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
