8 SYNOPSIS: This bill provides for an annual
9 appropriation to the State Board of Education in
10 the amount of \$5,000,000 for the Alabama Community
11 College System's dual enrollment programs.

12 This bill repeals the Education Employee
13 Liability Insurance Program established by Act
14 2013-215.

20 To provide for an annual appropriation within the
21 Education Trust Fund Appropriations Act to the State Board of
22 Education for the Alabama Community College System in the
23 amount of \$5,000,000 for dual enrollment programs; to provide
24 for the promulgation of rules by the Chancellor of the Alabama
25 Community College System; and to repeal Section 16-22-4.1,
26 Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the Education Employee
27 Liability Insurance Program.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. (a) Beginning with the 2014-2015 fiscal
3 year and ending with the 2019-2020 fiscal year, there shall be
4 appropriated within the Education Trust Fund Appropriations
5 Act, the amount of \$5,000,000 annually to the State Board of
6 Education for the Alabama Community College System's dual
7 enrollment programs.

8 (b) Dual Enrollment Programs are programs which
9 allow eligible high school students to enroll in college
10 courses concurrently with high school classes, either at the
11 college campus or at the high school, while receiving both
12 high school and college credit. Available courses may include
13 college-level courses in English, foreign languages,
14 mathematics, science, or social science;
15 occupational/technical courses; or any other courses agreed
16 upon by the school system and the college.

17 (c) The Chancellor of the Alabama Community College
18 System may promulgate rules in conformity with this section
19 regarding implementation of the requirements of this section.
20 Such rules shall include, but are not limited to, student
21 eligibility, eligible courses, registration procedures, and
22 cooperative agreements with school officials.

23 Section 2. It is not the intent of this act to make
24 appropriations, but the appropriations required by this act
25 shall be made in the annual Education Trust Fund
26 Appropriations act for the Community College System's dual
27 enrollment programs for the designated fiscal years.

1 Section 3. Section 16-22-4.1, Code of Alabama 1975,
2 establishing the Education Employee Liability Insurance
3 Program, is repealed.

4 Section 4. This act shall become effective on the
5 first day of the third month following its passage and
6 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
