charge of the room in which such class is held shall, for a 1 2 period of time not exceeding 15 minutes, instruct the class in the formal procedures followed by the United States Congress. 3 4 The study shall include, but not be limited to, a reading verbatim of one of the opening prayers given by the House or 5 Senate Chaplain or a guest member of the clergy at the 6 7 beginning of a meeting of the House of Representatives or the Senate. 8

9 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 10 first day of the third month following its passage and 11 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
