2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 To amend Section 32-6-1.2, Code of Alabama 1975,
4 relating to veteran's driver's licenses; to provide that
5 certain veterans may submit the veteran's Record and Report of
6 Separation Honorable Discharge Record to prove eligibility; to
7 provide for a veteran nondriver identification card; and to
8 authorize the Alabama Department of Public Health to issue a
9 certification card to persons with autism spectrum disorder to
10 be presented to law enforcement.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. Section 32-6-1.2, Code of Alabama 1975,
13 is amended to read as follows:

14 "§32-6-1.2.

15 "(a) The driver's license of a resident of this
16 state who is an honorably discharged veteran as evidenced by
17 the veteran's DD Form 214, or if the veteran does not have a
18 DD Form 214, as evidenced by the veteran's Record and Report
19 of Separation Honorable Discharge Record, upon request of the
20 eligible veteran, shall have the word veteran displayed on the
21 license.

22 "(b) The Department of Public Safety may not impose
23 any charge in addition to the driver's license fee for the
24 issuance or renewal of a veteran's driver's license."

1 Section 2. (a) The nondriver identification card of
2 a resident of this state who is an honorably discharged
3 veteran as evidenced by the veteran's DD Form 214, or if the
4 veteran does not have a DD Form 214, as evidenced by the
5 veteran's Record and Report of Separation Honorable Discharge
6 Record, upon request of the eligible veteran, shall have the
7 word veteran displayed on the nondriver identification card.

8 (b) The Department of Public Safety may not impose
9 any charge in addition to the nondriver identification card
10 fee for the issuance or renewal of a veteran's nondriver
11 identification card.

12 Section 3. (a) Upon the request of a person
13 medically diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder, or the
14 guardian or caregiver of the person, the Alabama Department of
15 Public Health shall issue a certification card denoting that
16 the person has been medically diagnosed with autism spectrum
17 disorder. The certification card and the person's driver's
18 license may be presented to law enforcement as necessary.

19 (b) The Alabama Department of Public Health shall
20 establish by rule the proof required to be produced by a
21 person medically diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder who
22 requests a certification card under subsection (a).

23 (c) The department may collect a reasonable fee for
24 the issuance of the certification card as determined by the
25 department.

1 Section 4. ~~This~~ Section 1 of this act shall become
2 effective on the first day of the third month following its
3 passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise
4 becoming law. Section 2 of this act shall become effective
5 January 1, 2015.
