Relating to the limits and boundaries of the territorial waters of this state for management and protection of marine resources; to provide legislative intent regarding the limits and boundaries of the territorial waters of this state management and protection of marine resources; and to amend Section 41-1-1 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for the limits and boundaries of the territorial waters of this state for management and protection of marine resources.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- Section 1. (a) The Legislature hereby finds, determines, and declares the following:
 - (1) Significant inequitable disparities exist in the limits and boundaries of the territorial waters and submerged lands among the Gulf Coast States of Texas, Florida, Louisiana, Mississippi, and Alabama.
 - (2) These inequities have resulted in economic and recreational losses to the State of Alabama, its political subdivisions, and its citizens.
 - (3) It is the policy and purpose of the State of Alabama by this act to place itself on an equal footing with the other Gulf Coast States with regard to the limits and boundaries of the territorial waters and submerged lands of

5	Section 2. Section 41-1-1 of the Code of Alabama
