Section 1. Section 11-46-7 of the Code of Alabama

1975, is amended to read as follows:

4 "\$11-46-7.

"(a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, except for those citizens of Birmingham that reside in Shelby County and those citizens of Birmingham that vote in the general election outside the Birmingham city limits, the polling places for municipal elections in any Class 1 municipality shall be the same as the polling places for general elections.

"(b) The polling places in which the Class 1 municipal election elections are held shall be in compliance with the requirements of the U.S. Department of Justice for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, shall submit all required information to the U.S. Department of Justice for pre-clearance to hold the election in time to receive the appropriate approval and conduct the election at the time specified by law, and shall provide all notification to the voters of Birmingham regarding their assigned voting locations and any special procedures to be implemented to accommodate ballots for any city council district within the same polling place.

"(c) In the event that a voter's district is changed because of redistricting due to the ten-year federal census requirement, his or her voting location in the precinct shall

1	be the voting location that is the closest to his or her
2	residence within the boundary of his or her new district.
3	"(d) Only one city council or school board district
4	per polling precinct shall be open for any municipal election
5	and for the election of the members of the city board of

7	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
8	first day of the third month following its passage and
9	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
