8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
9	Section 1. Section 22-20A-31, Code of Alabama 1975,
10	is amended to read as follows:

12	"(a) A food service establishment shall not
13	advertise or label a food item as catfish unless it is fish
14	classified within the family of Ictaluridae.
15	"(b) Any advertising of catfish or <u>other members of</u>
16	the Order of Siluriformes, or catfish products or siluriformes
17	products by food service establishments shall state the
18	country of origin if the product was imported from a country
19	other than the United States of America. The advertising
20	required in this subsection stating the country of origin of
21	the product shall be displayed daily when the catfish <u>or</u>
22	<u>siluriformes</u> or catfish products <u>or siluriformes products</u> are
23	from a country other than the United States of America.
24	"(c) No catfish <u>or siluriformes</u> product shall be
25	offered for sale at a food service establishment unless
26	consumers are notified of the name and country of origin of
27	the product. A food service establishment shall comply with

this requirement by listing the country of origin on the menu 1 in the same location and in the same size font as the product 2 being offered, or by using a sign or tabletop display 3 4 identifying the country of origin of the catfish offered for sale. If a sign is used, it shall be a minimum of 93 square 5 inches with characters at least one inch in size. The sign or 6 7 a series of signs shall be posted on a wall in a conspicuous location or locations in plain view of all patrons. If a 8 tabletop display is used, it shall be at least 30 square 9 10 inches and be placed on each table that is used for service." Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 11 12 first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
