At the completion of the current term of office of each circuit court judge and each district court judge, in the 15th Judicial Circuit comprised of Montgomery County, the next term of office and each term of office thereafter for circuit court judges and district court judges shall be four years.

An election upon the proposed amendment 10 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the 11 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 12 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 13 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 14 state.

15 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 16 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 17 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 18 following description of the substance or subject matter of 19 the proposed constitutional amendment:
