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8	SYNOPSIS:	Under existing law, a person is guilty of
9		trafficking in controlled substance analogues if he
10		or she knowingly sells, manufactures, delivers, or

14		weight for trafficking in controlled substance
15		analogues to 56 grams.
16		Under existing law, certain named chemical
17		compounds of synthetic cannabinoid and other

20		Possession, distribution, and trafficking of these
21		compounds is unlawful, and violations are subject

24		This bill would include additional synthetic

26		Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama
27		of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the

Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general law whose purpose or effect would be to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds from becoming effective with regard to a local governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote unless: it comes within one of a number of specified exceptions; it is approved by the affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to the entity for the purpose.

The purpose or effect of this bill would be to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of the amendment. However, the bill does not require approval of a local governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to become effective because it comes within one of the specified exceptions contained in the amendment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as Landon's Law.

Section 2. Sections 13A-12-231 and 20-2-23, Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

- 3 tetrahydrocannabinols which contain more than 15 percent by

"c. Is one kilo but less than 10 kilos, then the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

- "(11) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures, delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of methamphetamine or any mixture containing methamphetamine, its salts, optical isomers, or salt of its optical isomers thereof, is guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in methamphetamine." If the quantity involved:
- "a. Is 28 grams or more but less than 500 grams, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).
- "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

Provided, however, that the sentence of imprisonment for a defendant with one or more prior felony convictions who violates subdivisions (1) through (12) of this section shall be the sentence provided therein, or the sentence provided under Section 13A-5-9, whichever is greater. Provided further, that the fine for a defendant with one or more prior felony convictions who violates subdivisions (1) through (12) of this section shall be the fine provided therein, or the fine provided under Section 13A-5-9, whichever is greater.

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"(a) The Legislature finds the following:

1 "(1) New synthetic substances are being created 2 which are not controlled under the provisions of existing state law but which have a potential for abuse similar to or 3 greater than that for substances controlled under existing state law. 21	substitution at the nitrogen atom of the ethanamine with
22	alkyl, alkyl halide, alkenyl, cycloalkylmethyl,
23	cycloalkylethyl, phenyl, benzyl whether or not further
24	substituted in the (either) phenyl ring to any extent.
25	"19. Any compound structurally related to
26	2,5-dimethoxy-4-chloroamphetamine by substitution of the
27	chloro moiety (4 position) with other halides, alkyl, alkyl

1	halides, thioalkyl, cycloalkyl, cycloalkylhalides and/or
2	substitution at the nitrogen atom with alkyl, alkyl halide,
3	alkenyl, cycloalkylmethyl, cycloalkylethyl, phenyl, benzyl
4	whether or not further substituted in the (either) phenyl ring
5	to any extent.
6	"20. Any compound structurally related to
7	2-amino-1-phenyl-1-propanone (cathinone) by substitution of
8	the amine with alkyl, alkyl halide, alkenyl, cycloalkylmethyl,
9	cycloalkylethyl, phenyl, benzyl whether or not further
10	substituted in the (either) phenyl ring to any extent.
11	"21. Any compound structurally related to
12	a-pyrrolidinopentiophenone (a-pvp) whether or not further
13	substituted in the phenyl ring to any extent, whether or not
14	further substituted in the pyrrolidine ring to any extent.
15	"b. A controlled substance analog <u>synthetic</u>
16	controlled substance or analogue in subdivision (4) or this
17	subdivision does not include any of the following:
18	"1. Any substance for which there is an approved new
19	drug application under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic
20	Act.
21	"2. With respect to a particular person, any
22	substance, if an exemption is in effect for investigational
23	use, for that person, as provided by 21 U.S.C. § 355, and the
24	person is registered as a controlled substance researcher as
25	required under section 152.12, subdivision 3, to the extent
26	conduct with respect to the substance is pursuant to the

exemption and registration.

"c. A controlled substance analog analogue, to the

extent intended for human consumption, is treated as a

controlled substance in Schedule I.

"d. After the Alabama Department of Forensic Sciences has determined a substance to be a <u>synthetic</u> controlled substance <u>analog</u> <u>analogue</u> under this section, the department shall notify the Alabama Department of Public Health with information relevant to scheduling as provided by Section 20-2-20."

Section 3. Although this bill would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime.

Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
