Relating to the City of Enterprise in Coffee and Dale Counties; authorizing the sale of draft or keg beer or malt beverages by properly licensed retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board upon the consent of the City of Enterprise City Council.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. This act shall only apply to the City of
10 Enterprise in Coffee and Dale Counties.

11 Section 2. The sale of draft or keg beer or malt 12 beverages by retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage 13 Control Board is authorized in the City of Enterprise. All 14 resolutions and ordinances relating to the sale, consumption, 15 and possession of bottled or canned beer in the town shall 16 apply to draft or keg beer or malt beverages. The City of 17 Enterprise City Council may adopt an ordinance regulating the 18 sale of draft or keg beer or malt beverages pursuant to this 19 act.

20 Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict 21 with this act are repealed. However, the provisions of this 22 act are cumulative and supplementary and shall not be 23 construed to repeal or supersede any laws or parts of laws not 24 directly inconsistent herewith. HB539
