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22	To exempt food pantries in St. Clair County which
23	distribute food for charitable purposes from all state,
24	county, and municipal sales and use taxes under certain
25	conditions.
26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this act, a "food pantry" is a charitable, nonprofit organization which collects, purchases, or otherwise accumulates food and food related items for distribution without any charge for charitable purposes.

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(b) A food pantry in St. Clair County is exempt from all state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes on the purchase or distribution of food and food related items for charitable purposes provided the food pantry has been granted status as a tax exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the federal Internal Revenue Code and provided it pays no person any salary or expenses for the performance of any duties related to its charitable operations.

Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
