18	Section 1. Act 84-540 of the 1984 Regular Session
19	(Acts 1984, p. 1166), is amended to read as follows:
20	"Section 1. In Jackson County, the sum of one
21	thousand three hundred seventy-nine dollars and ninety-five
22	cents ($$1,379.95$), or the amount as otherwise provided in this
23	section, is hereby appropriated monthly for the relief of Mr.
24	Willie Dean Mount. The monthly appropriations shall be payable
25	as non-employee compensation from any funds available for the
26	operation of the office of the sheriff. The monthly
27	appropriation of one thousand three hundred seventy-nine

dollars and ninety-five cents (\$1,379.95) shall be reduced by
any and all amounts of workmen's compensation or disability
payments payable to and received by Willie Dean Mount, but
shall in no event shall the amount be less than six hundred
eighty-three dollars and ninety-five cents (\$683.95) per
month.

"Section 2. The operation of this act, as amended by the act amending this section, shall be retroactive to the date that the combined sum of worker's compensation benefits and Social Security disability benefits equaled one thousand three hundred seventy-nine dollars and ninety-five cents (\$1,379.95), and all actions taken and payments made pursuant thereto on and after that date are ratified and confirmed."

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
