4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To amend Section 31-10-2, Code of Alabama 1975,
6 relating to the Alabama National Guard Educational Assistance
7 Act, to revise the definition of tuition.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Section 31-10-2 of the Code of Alabama
10 1975, is amended to read as follows:

11 "§31-10-2.

12 "The following words used in this article shall have
13 the meanings as set forth by this section:

14 "(1) ALABAMA NATIONAL GUARD. Federally recognized
15 units of the Alabama National Guard.

16 "~~(3)~~ (2) ACTIVE MEMBER. A member of a federally
17 recognized unit of the Alabama National Guard meeting the
18 minimum requirements for satisfactory membership as defined in
19 the Department of the Army and Department of the Air Force
20 regulations.

21 "~~(5)~~ (3) TUITION. The cost of instruction and fees to
22 the student as stated in the institution's catalog, plus the
23 average cost of books and supplies, to a minimum of one
24 hundred dollars (\$100), and not to exceed \$500 per semester or
25 quarter or not more than \$1,000 annually 50 percent of the

1 remaining balance after all federal benefits have been applied
2 to the account of the student, for a total amount not
3 exceeding two thousand dollars (\$2,000) annually.

4 "(4) VETERAN. Any person with more than 180 days
5 active duty under Title 10, United States Code, annotated, and
6 entitled to federal educational benefits will be considered a
7 veteran and not eligible for benefits under this article.

8 "~~(2)~~(5) WORDS IMPORTING THE MASCULINE GENDER ONLY.
9 Apply to female as well as male."

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
11 first day of the third month following its passage and
12 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
