4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To repeal Section 13A-5-9.1, Code of Alabama 1975,  
6 relating to the Habitual Offender Act and providing for the  
7 retroactive application of the act as amended.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Section 13A-5-9.1, Code of Alabama 1975,  
10 is repealed.

11 Section 2. This act shall be applied prospectively  
12 only. Any case, on the effective date of this act, in which a  
13 motion filed pursuant to Section 13A-5-9.1, Code of Alabama  
14 1975, is pending in the trial court or is subject to an appeal  
15 or pending in an appellate court on appeal from the denial or  
16 dismissal of a motion shall not be affected by this act.

17 Section 3. This act shall become effective  
18 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
