SB115 1 2 3 ENROLLED, An Act, 4 To amend Sections 38-4-2, 38-4-4 and 38-11A-2 Code 5 of Alabama 1975, relating to public assistance and the 6 7 eligibility for means-tested public benefits to include the 8 income of a cohabiting partner when determining eligibility 9 for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF); to require 10 that an applicant for TANF apply for at least three positions 11 of unsubsidized employment prior to applying for TANF cash 12 assistance from the Department of Human Resources; and to 13 provide that TANF recipients who voluntarily terminate 14 employment shall be ineligible for receiving TANF cash 15 assistance. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 16 Section 1. Sections 38-4-2, 38-4-4, and 38-11A-2 17 18 Code of Alabama 1975, are hereby amended to read as follows: "§38-4-2. 19 20 "(a) Applications for Temporary Assistance for Needy 21 Families (TANF) cash assistance shall be made to the county 22 department in the manner prescribed by the state department and shall contain such information as the state department may 23 24 require; provided, that nothing contained in this chapter 25 shall be construed as requiring the signing of a pauper's oath

on the part of any person making application for assistance 1 2 hereunder. An investigation and record shall be promptly made 3 by the county department of the circumstances of the applicant. Upon the completion of the investigation the county 4 5 director shall determine whether the applicant is eligible for assistance under the provisions of this chapter and the rules 6 and regulations of the state department and the amount of 7 8 assistance he shall receive. The county director shall give 9 notice in writing to the applicant of the action taken on his 10 application or any subsequent change in payments.

11 "(b) Within maximum matchable payments in which the federal government will participate as prescribed in the 12 13 Federal Social Security Act, the amount of assistance to which 14 any person described in Section 38-4-1 shall be entitled 15 shall, under the rules and regulations of the state 16 department, be determined upon the basis of the amount of 17 total income and resources received by such person the 18 applicant, the husband or wife of the applicant and/or the 19 cohabiting partner of the applicant, as provided by rules 20 promulgated by the Department of Human Resources, except as provided in Section 38-4-1, and such other conditions existing 21 22 in each case as will determine the need for assistance for 23 such person as provided in this chapter. The amount of such 24 assistance shall be determined with due regard to the 25 conditions existing in each case, subject to the funds

"§38-4-4. 6 "If at any time the recipient of public assistance, 7 8 or the husband or wife of such recipient, and/or the cohabiting partner of the recipient, as provided by rules 9 10 promulgated by the Department of Human Resources, shall become 11 possessed of any income or resources in excess of that owned or being received at the date of the application, it shall be 12 13 the duty of the recipient immediately to notify the county 14 department of the facts in the case. The county department, 15 upon the notification or upon otherwise learning the facts, 16 shall, after investigation, continue, reduce or cancel the 17 amount of the grant as the facts may warrant. Its action in 18 this respect shall be subject to appeal and review as provided 19 in this chapter. For the purposes of this section, where aid to dependent children is the form of public assistance 20 21 involved, the near relative, as defined in the Federal Social 22 Security Act, shall report the acquisition of income and

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resources.

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"(a) The Department of Human Resources shall 1 establish and administer a welfare employment program for 2 3 persons applying for, or receiving, public assistance in the State of Alabama. The department shall develop program policy, 4 5 criteria, requirements, and procedures and issue rules and regulations for governance of the program, insofar as federal 6 7 quidelines permit, and shall assume program management 8 responsibilities including budget planning, cost accounting, data collecting and reporting, evaluation and assessment of 9 10 program performance, and standards for effective use of 11 distributed funds. The program shall include development of 12 employment strategies, employment-related programs and activities and family support services directed toward 13 14 affecting the intent and goals of this chapter. 15 "(b) As a condition of eligibility for Temporary 16 Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) an applicant shall have 17 applied for at least three positions of unsubsidized 18 employment prior to completing the application process and comply with job search preparation, education, and other 19 employment activities as required by the Department. 20 21 "(c) Recipients of TANF cash assistance who 22 voluntarily terminate employment or refuse employment without 23 good cause shall be ineligible for TANF cash assistance."

Section 2. Notwithstanding the provisions in Section
1, TANF cash assistance and eligibility requirements shall

1 conform with federal eligibility requirement standards as
2 provided for in Title IV, Part A, of the Social Security Act.
3 Section 3. This act shall become effective
4 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor or
5 its otherwise becoming law.
